

The Chemistry and Biochemistry (CBC) Department at the University of Arizona College of Science invite exceptional candidates to apply for a tenure-track faculty position in the department, for a start date in Fall 2017. Applicants with research and teaching interests in all areas of biochemistry are encouraged to apply.
