- Scientific support and further development of electron microscopy in the Key Lab
- Orientation and training of doctoral and postdoctoral researchers in theory and practice
- Participation in labs and internships for master's students and doctoral researchers

- A university degree and doctorate in natural sciences or engineering
- Relevant experience in electron microscopy
- Experience applying for, operating, and monitoring large-scale research equipment
- The ability to work in a team, strong communication skills, constructive collaboration with scientists and administrative staff
- A solution-oriented and independent way of working as well as a convincing demeanor
- Experience in personnel management would be an asset
